



Code of Conduct for Players and Supporters

- Cricket shall be played and supported in the spirit of the game.
- Doubleview Carine Cricket Club players and supporters shall adhere to the WASTCA code of conduct and any variances noted within this document.
- The Doubleview Carine Cricket Club supports the WASTCA code of conduct and will act in its accordance either dependently or independently.
- All supporters are encouraged to attend Doubleview Carine Cricket Club fixtures and abide by this code.
- Doubleview Carine Cricket Club players and supporters shall respect opposition players, opposition supporters, opposition officials and umpires.
- The Doubleview Carine Cricket Club will not tolerate racial taunts or any personal attacks against other players, supporters or officials in any form, whether verbal or physical.
- Doubleview Carine Cricket Club players are to accept the umpire's decision and so honour the spirit of the game.
- Doubleview Carine Cricket Club Captains and Officials are to immediately address actions outside this code and deal with them as they see fit. Severe actions outside this code must be brought to the attention of the Committee immediately for mediation.
- Multiple disciplinary misdemeanours can result in the deregistration of a player from Doubleview Carine Cricket Club.
- Respect fellow Doubleview Carine Cricket Club Members and Officials. Discuss any problems with the Doubleview Carine Cricket Club Players' Representative.
- Alcohol is not to be brought to any licensed WASTCA ground, including Monyash Reserve. A full list of WASTCA licensed grounds can be found on the association website.
