Service

All servers are responsible servers of alcohol as defined by the Liquor Act. They will make responsible decisions based on their training. Members are expected to abide by their judgement and respect their decisions as they are made for your safety and security. Service will only be allowed via the bar and will not be granted to people that are clearly intoxicated. Low alcohol beverages and water are available at all times. Canteen food is also available.

Conduct

The Doubleview Carine Cricket Club requires that Members and visitors conduct themselves in a respectful and reasonable manner whilst on the premises.

Respect of fellow Members and Officials is paramount. Destructive or anti-social behaviour will result in removal from the premises and report to the executive committee for discipline.

Noise

Members are asked to be considerate of neighbouring residents whilst at or leaving the premises. Special care should be taken to limit noise levels late at night and whilst outside the rooms.
