



Selection Policy

This policy is written to use as a guideline to clarify and streamline the selection process.

Players will always be selected with the best interest of the Club in mind. At times where a player indicates a preference to play in a particular grade this may be considered, but ultimately players will be selected where the needs of the Club are best met.

The One Day XI is effectively the Club's 4th XI and movement between the grades will reflect this.

Criteria which selectors will use include:

- Financial status
- On field performance – results and form
- Team balance
- Attendance and performance at training
- Past and future availability
- (On rare occasions) qualification for finals consideration
- (On rare occasions) disciplinary measures

Relevant People

- **Captains:** Each Captain is a selector for his grade only.
- **Selector/s:** The Committee will appoint a Selector/s at the beginning of each season who will act in this role. The Selector/s is charged with coordinating selections.
- **President:** The President will supply the Selector/s a list of Unfinancial Players on a Monday. He will also be given a copy of the selected teams prior to announcement to ensure all players are financial and to enter the teams into MyCricket.
- **Secretary:** After teams are announced, the Secretary will email the sides to all Members.

Timing

- The Selector/s will liaise with all captains early in the week to develop provisional teams for the upcoming fixtures.
- A final Selection meeting will be held on Thursday nights, after training.
- Final teams are announced on Thursday nights after training at 7.45pm.
- Final teams are always announced subject to change due to injury, illness and availability.

Selection Meetings

- Discussion at selection meetings is to be confidential.
- Only the Selector/s and Captain may attend selection meetings.

- These people are to, wherever possible; make themselves available to attend selection meetings.
- The Selector/s are responsible for co-ordinating the selection meeting and decision-making process.

Role of the Committee

The Committee has no role in the selection of teams.

The Committee appoints the Selector/s and Captains at the beginning of the season.

Any issues with selection need to be directed to the Selector/s.
